

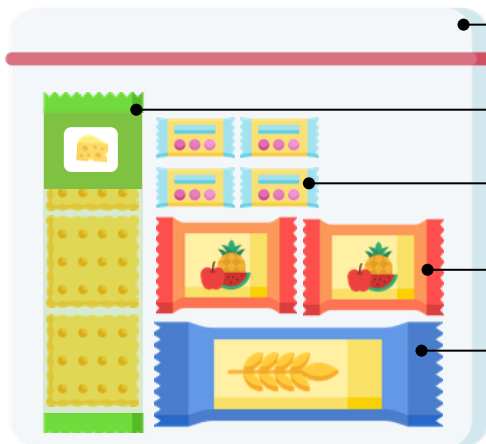

SNACK BAGS

Assembly Instructions

Each month, an average of **5,000 families**, whom we call neighbors, visit our food pantry to receive grocery items to prepare nutritious meals for their families. Some of these families also visit our clothing closet, which distributes, on average, approximately **8,000 articles of clothing** monthly. You and your organization have the opportunity to provide snack bags for the children of our neighbors who visit our food pantry. Each snack bag contains:



Ziploc Bag (One)

Sandwich size

Sandwich Crackers (One)

Non-Melting Candy (Four-Five)*

i.e., Starbursts, Skittles, Gummy Bears, etc.

Fruit Snacks (Two)

~0.8 - 0.9oz packs

Granola Bar (One)

**No gum, hard candy, or sour candy please. Please include four to five individual pieces or one snack-size pack.*
