

THE STOREHOUSE OF COLLIN COUNTY VOLUNTEER RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY

This agreement is entered into between The Storehouse of Collin County ("Storehouse") and the undersigned volunteer with respect to participation in volunteer activities for Storehouse. In consideration of such participation, Volunteer freely and without duress agrees as follows:

1. Volunteer agrees for Volunteer and his or her heirs, executors and administrators, not to sue and to release, indemnify and hold harmless, The Storehouse of Collin County, and its affiliates, officers, directors, volunteers, agents, and employees from any and all liability, claims, demands and causes of action whatsoever, arising out of my participation in this event and related activities, whether it results from the negligence of any of the above or from any other cause.

2. Volunteer authorizes any medical treatment deemed necessary in the event of an injury while participating in such activities and hereby releases and forever discharges Storehouse from any claim whatsoever that arises or may arise on account of any first aid, treatment, or service rendered in connection with the Volunteer's work for Storehouse.

3. Volunteer understands and accepts that the activities may include a variety of activities including but not limited to bending, lifting, carrying and transporting supplies or food stocks, and working outdoors. The activities may be considered hazardous activities and have many dangers and risks. Volunteer hereby agrees to freely and expressly assume and accept all risks of injury.

4. Volunteer represents that Volunteer is physically fit and adequately trained to safely participate in these activities, and that Volunteer does not suffer from any injury, defect, ailment, illness or the like which could conceivably lead to injury or death from participation in this activity. Volunteer represents that he can lift a minimum of 20 lbs.

5. Volunteer represents that at the time Volunteer is present for the activities that Volunteer is free from illness and has been fever free (no fever in excess of 99.6) for a minimum of 72 hours prior to the time Volunteer appears for activities.

6. Volunteer expressly agrees that the foregoing waiver of liability, assumption of risk and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the laws of the State of Texas and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect. Wherever used herein, a pronoun in the masculine gender shall be considered as including the feminine gender unless the context clearly indicates otherwise.

Acknowledgment of Understanding: I have read this waiver of liability, assumption of risk and indemnity agreement, fully understand its terms, and **understand that I am giving up substantial rights, including my right to sue.** I acknowledge that I am signing the agreement freely and voluntarily and **intend by my signature to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability** to the greatest extent allowed by the laws of the State of Texas.
