Two Campuses, One Mission

As the end of August is in sight, I hope your summer has been full of rest, respite, and wonderful memories!

This has been a monumental summer for The Storehouse Community Center. As Reverend Arthur Jones of St. Andrew Methodist Church and I shared last November, The Storehouse has acquired additional space four miles away in Carrollton ([2855 Trinity Square; Carrollton 75006](#)), strategically located near the largest zip code of Storehouse neighbors served on a continual basis. While our Seven Loaves Food Pantry will remain on the St. Andrew campus, this expansion opens the door for much-needed growth of our other key programs - Joseph's Coat, Project Hope, and The Academy - as well as our workforce development initiative.

The new campus includes two 15,000+-square-foot buildings, which offer greatly increased capacity and opportunities to serve our neighbors. We are taking a phased approach to construction and renovations based on careful planning and budgeting. Phase 1 of renovations began in June and has focused on enhancing the entryway, updating portions of the exterior, and most importantly, preparing a welcoming and functional space for serving our neighbors.

From a programmatic perspective, I am thrilled to share that Joseph's Coat will open in our new facility this fall. We'll spend the first half of September moving and setting up the clothing closet. The second half of the month will serve as a "soft opening" as we begin welcoming limited numbers of neighbors into the space. We will officially open Joseph's Coat for service in the expansion campus beginning October 1. Our clothing collection bins in the north parking lot of St. Andrew and inside the north entrance of the church will remain on the church campus for all your donations, which are very much needed!

The Academy will continue to serve from the St. Andrew campus until Phase 2 of the renovation is complete, which we are currently anticipating for the end of 2026/early 2027. Visioning for Phase 2 will begin later this fall. Project Hope will serve from both campuses beginning October of this year.
